
replacing Agnes Yates, whose term will end on June 30, 2008, as a member of the Board for a term to end June 30, 2012.



A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To confirm the appointment of Ms. Lori Lee to the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia.
