**SUBJECT:** Change of Duty Status for Metropolitan Police Academy Officer Anthony Clay,  
FIT Case S-F-07-489, IS: 07-004477

On Monday, September 17, 2007, at approximately 7:38 PM, Special Operations Division Officer James Haskel became involved in a Use of Service Pistol (Glock-17) in which he discharged eight (8) rounds from his departmentally issued service pistol fatally wounding a subject who had discharged a handgun at him. Metropolitan Police Academy Officer Anthony Clay, who was with Officer Haskel at the time of the shooting, was placed in an Administrative Leave duty status due to medical reasons.

The Force Investigation Team initiated a preliminary review of this case. Moreover, the Force Investigation Team has found no issues of concern regarding Officer Clay's role at this stage of the investigation that would preclude his return to full duty.

It has therefore been determined by the Office of Professional Responsibility that Officer Clay shall be placed in a Full-Duty Status, in accordance with the provisions set forth in General Order 901.11 (Force Related Duty Status Determination) once he is cleared by the Medical Services Division.
