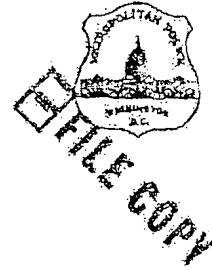

SUBJECT: Change of Duty Status for Special Operations Division Officer James Haskel,
FIT Case S-F-07-469, IS 07-004477

On Monday, September 17, 2007, at approximately 7:36 PM, Special Operations Division Officer James Haskel became involved in a Use of Service Pistol (Glock-17) in which he discharged eight (8) rounds from his departmentally issued service pistol fatally wounding a suspect who had discharged a handgun at the officer.

The Force Investigation Team initiated a preliminary review of this case in conjunction with the United States Attorney's Office. Moreover, the Force Investigation Team has found no issues of concern regarding Officer Haskel's role at this stage of the investigation that would preclude his return to full duty.

It has therefore been determined by the Office of Professional Responsibility that Officer Haskel shall be placed in a Full-Duty Status, in accordance with the provisions set forth in General Order 901.11 (Force Related Duty Status Determination) once he is cleared by the Medical Services Division. Please forward a copy of the PD-77 to the Office of Professional Responsibility upon completion.
